- 1. The deliberations at BOG meeting regarding the result analysis of the public examinations conducted during April 2015, 2016 & 2017 were informed the staff members through staff meeting. Departments have been instructed to initiate steps to further improve the results.
- 2. AICTE-ISTE sanctioned Rs. 3 lakhs for organising FDP on the topic "Planning & Preparation for Teachers". Around 31 teachers from different polytechnics attended the programme.
- 3. Students were given awareness program on the importance of involving in innovative projects inside and outside campus. Rupees TWO lakhs as innovation grant was awarded to Master Adarsh K of Mechanical department for his project idea "WHITE BOX", by Kerala Start-up Mission.
- 4. More students started coming up with new project and innovation ideas.
